

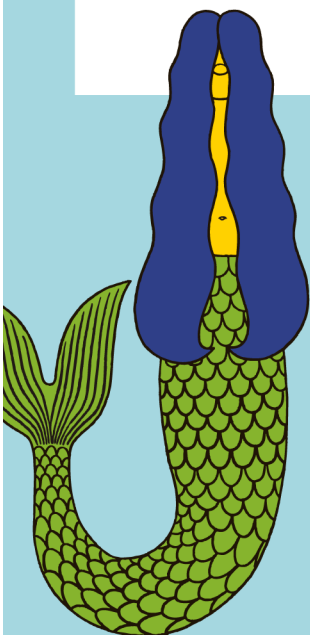


NAUTICAL TRIVIA

- 1 The Galápagos Islands are located in the Pacific Ocean approximately 906 kilometers (563 miles) west of mainland Ecuador.
- 2 The Galápagos Islands is a group that consists of 13 main islands, 6 smaller islands, and 107 islets or rocks.
- 3 The most famous resident of the Galápagos islands was Lonesome George, who was the only surviving giant Pinta Island tortoise left on Earth. He was known as the rarest creature in the world and served as a symbol for conservation. Lonesome George died on the 24th June 2012 at the age of 100.
- 4 The Galápagos are home to a turtle that can live up to 150 years. That is the longest lifespan of any animal on Earth! A full grown adult can weigh over 300 kilograms and measure 1.2 meters long.
- 5 The Galápagos Islands are home to the only breeding penguin in the northern hemisphere.
